The food and beverage experience he acquired in his early years served him well as he now operates Dell'Anno's Pizzeria in Brosville Station and Katie's Pretzels in Piedmont Mall.

Expanding into the Downtown Historic District is a dream come true for Agostino and his wife Brandi as they both share a passion for the character of downtowns. "My wife and I love downtowns and historic buildings," commented Pugliese. "We are extremely excited about opening our third restaurant in the Downtown Historic District and hope that we can inspire other new businesses to locate in a district that is currently undergoing a true revitalization effort."

Working with the City of Danville Office of Economic Development, the Pugliese's qualified for a Downtown Development Enhancement Grant which gives funds to targeted new businesses to locate within the Downtown or the Tobacco Warehouse Historic Districts. "It is a very exciting time for downtown," said Anne Moore-Sparks, Project Manager for the Office of Economic Development. "I am deeply appreciative for the Pugliese's investment in downtown. Their passion for the district as well as their past successes and experience in the restaurant business will be a welcome addition to the district."
