

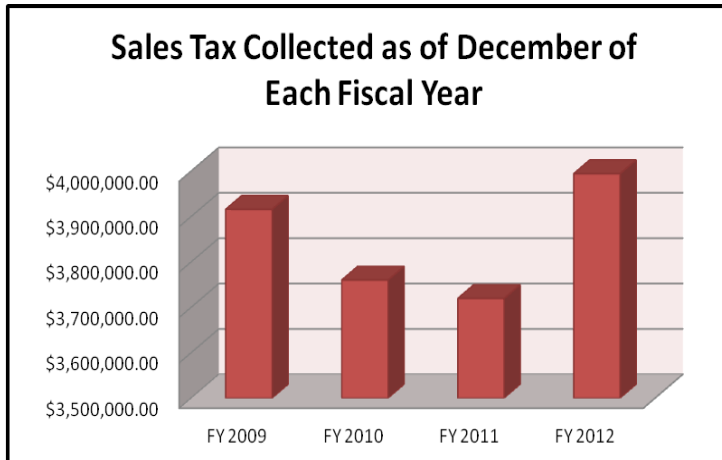
### PURPOSE

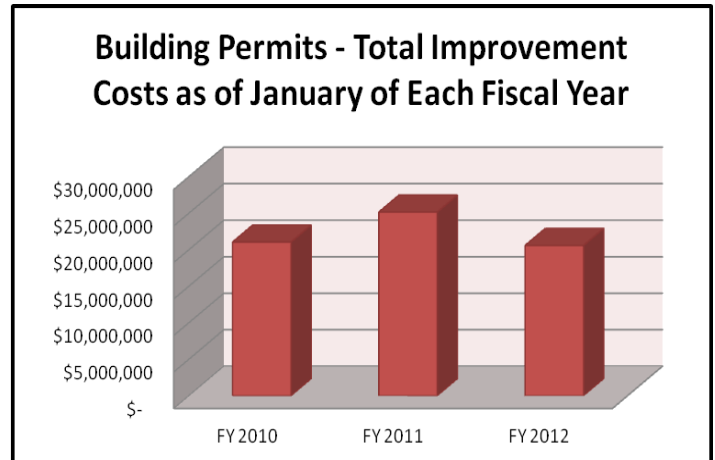

### OUTLOOK

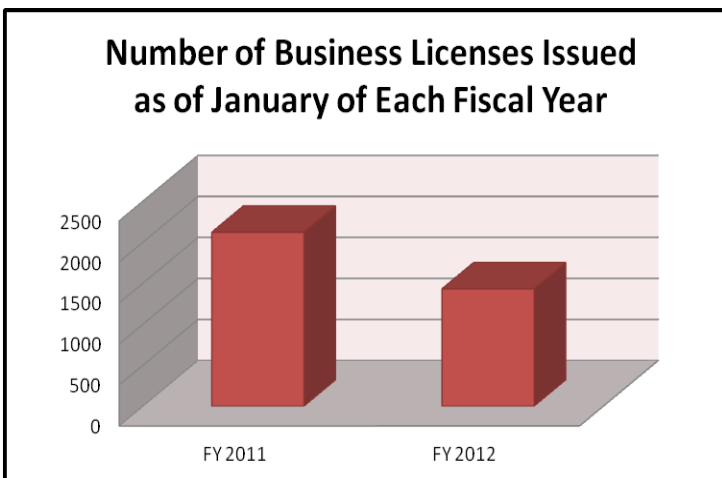
Based on the information below, the majority of Danville's key economic indicators continue to remain sluggish compared to previous fiscal years. Even though the total improvement costs associated with building permits has seen two months (December 2011 and January 2012) of increase, this indicator along with other business related indicators are still lagging behind for the fiscal year. On the contrary, the amount of sales tax collected continues to steadily increase. Although the unemployment rate has much room for improvement, it is important to note that during the 2012 fiscal year this rate has been between 0.8% and 2.4% lower each month compared to the previous year. We anticipate that the updated list of economic development announcements on the second page will help this rate to continually drop, as well as create positive change for the remaining indicators.



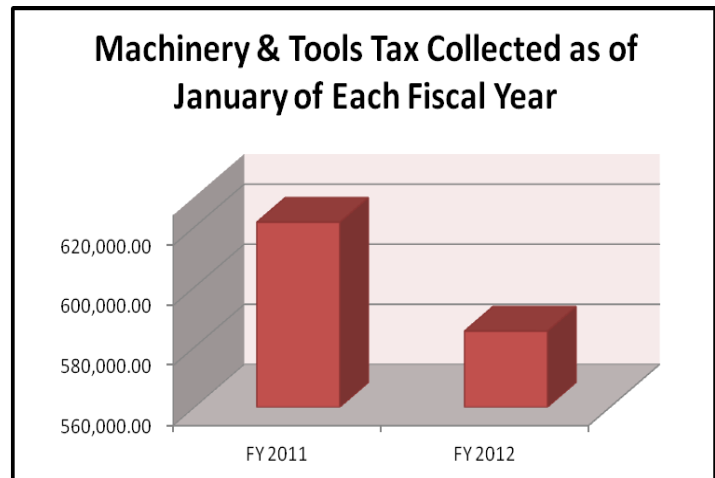

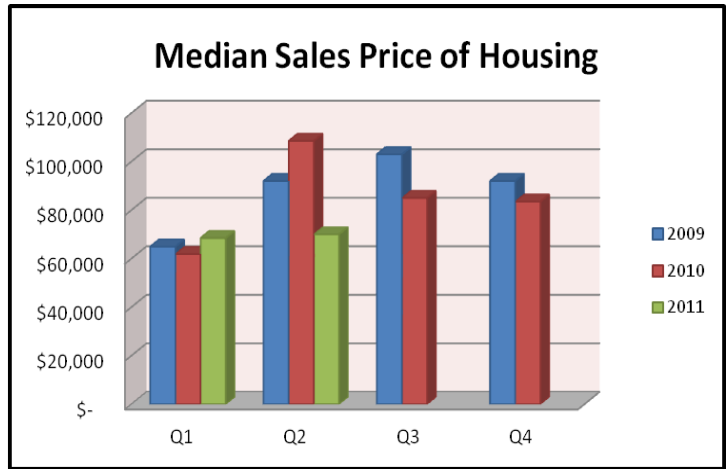
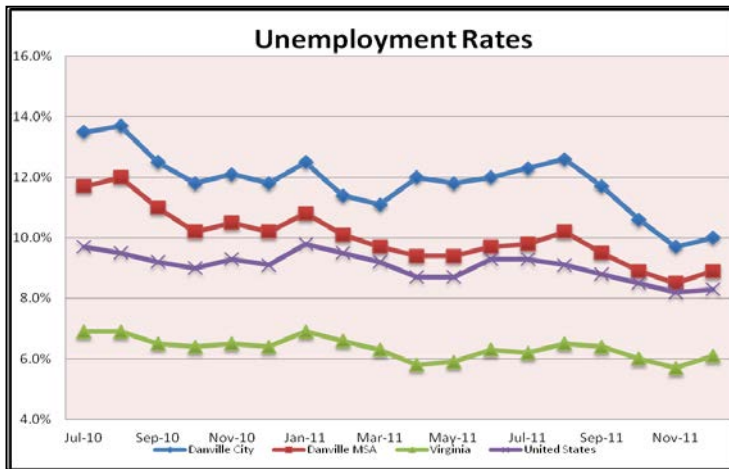
