Utility Assistance Grant

- Will cover 50% of payment due (up to \$10,000) of delinquent utility payments for businesses
- Business must have received a disconnection notice from the City of Danville

Personal Protective Equipment and Services Grant

- Payment or reimbursement of up to \$2,500 for the purchase of personal protective equipment and services

Outdoor Seating, Curbside Pick-Up, and Take-Out Grant

- Payment or reimbursement of up to \$10,000 for the purchase of items or services to help enhance outdoor seating, curbside pick-up, or take-out options for restaurants

Marketing and eCommerce Grant

- Payment or reimbursement of up to \$2,500 to be used towards paid marketing efforts and eCommerce upgrades

- To assist small businesses, sole proprietors, independent contractors, and "gig" workers that are impacted by decline in economic activities due to COVID-19 pandemic. Administered by DRREE, the funds (\$50,000 in total and \$2,500 per awardee) will be granted to these small businesses and entrepreneurs
