City celebrates grand reopening of Danville Visitor Center

The Danville Office of Economic Development & Tourism (DOEDT) hosted a grand reopening of the Danville Visitor Center, 645 River Park Drive, on Thursday, October 16, to celebrate the renovated space.

The upgraded Visitor Center includes a redesigned interior layout with a centralized reception desk, an expanded patio, training space, improved storage for merchandise and collateral, and enhanced technology features, such as a sound dome. The renovation, which began in February 2025, was made possible through a collaboration with local partners, Dewberry and Quality Construction, and the City of Danville Public Works Department.

City and tourism leaders gathered to commemorate the occasion, including Alonzo Jones, Danville Mayor, Lisa Meriwether, DOEDT Tourism Manager, and Rita McClenny, CEO and President of the Virginia Tourism Corporation, who shared remarks highlighting the impact of the Visitor Center on enhancing the visitor experience.
